The Bridgman Public Library reserves the right for library staff to refuse a copying order, if, in its judgment, fulfillment of the order would involve violation of copyright law.

This includes, but is not limited to:

Books

CDs – audio and/or software

DVDs

Electronic materials (website, electronic databases, etc)

Periodicals

Photographs

Staff will make copies:

- 1. If you are the copyright owner.
- 2. If the item is no longer under copyright.
- 3. Of a small portion (one [1] copy for personal use of any item under copyright).
